- He left Unilever in 1998 to take up a position with DHL Supply Chain. With DHL I worked in the UK, Saudi Arabia (where he was General Manager of a Joint Venture with the Olayan Group), Dubai and Eastern Europe
- After leaving DHL in 2012 he worked for Halliburton in the Oilfield Support industry prior to joining SMSCMC in February 2016 as Supply Chain and Delivery Director
